**Invitation to participate in feasibility assessment of innovative pharmacy measure concepts**

The Pharmacy Quality Alliance (PQA), in collaboration with the Community Pharmacy Foundation (CPF), has engaged a multi-stakeholder panel of thought leaders including providers, pharmacy practitioners, payers, employers, technology vendors and patients for a series of virtual summit meetings to advance quality measurement for community pharmacy.

During the first two summit meetings in the Fall of 2020, the panel identified a list of eight high-priority measure concepts. The next stage of the project is to complete a systematic feasibility assessment of each prioritized measure concept to better understand the availability, standardization, and interoperability of data elements required to implement the measures. **Our PQA team is seeking pharmacy, payer, and system vendor stakeholders to complete a feasibility evaluation tool to objectively assess the data elements associated with each measure concept.** We aim to receive all results **by February 19, 2021**. This will allow our team to compile the results in advance of our next summit meeting. Your feedback through the tool will inform summit participants' understanding of the feasibility of prioritized measure concepts and will support our collective goal to advance performance measurement that demonstrates the value of community pharmacy practice.
