Standard of Care & Transforming Pharmacy Practice: A Roadmap for Community Pharmacists & State Associations

Objectives

- Develop comprehensive resources for community pharmacists that aid in transforming their practice within a Standard of Care framework.
- Create a roadmap to guide other state associations in implementing a Standard of Care framework in their states, from start to finish. Details for the SOC Symposium, including agenda, CE plan, speakers and topics will be shared as part of this roadmap as well as other useful pre-symposium resources.
 IPA will seek to collaborate with NABP, NASPA and AACP in dissemination of such toolkit.
- Host a high-impact Standard of Care Symposium that will bring together pharmacy professionals
 from all practice settings from across the state to educate, support and address the impact of the
 Standard of Care on all pharmacy practice settings. Community pharmacists that attend the
 Symposium will leave with a roadmap to understand new opportunities and templates for evolving
 their pharmacy practice.

Results

- Development and dissemination of standard of care information and resources through https://www.iarx.org/soc
- Hosted the Standard of Care Symposium and Leadership Summit (>200 attendees)
- Hosted Community Pharmacy Practice Forum discussing standard of care implementation (65 attendees)
- Completed 7 of 8 continuing education training sessions on standard of care implementation (257 attendees)

Conclusion

- IPA successfully developed materials to support education and training of pharmacists, technicians, and state pharmacy association leaders to implement a standard of care regulatory model.
- Multiple different methods were used to expand knowledge and implementation of standard of care related practices including development of digital resources, continuing education, in-person training, virtual training, and facilitated policy advancement discussions.
- Dissemination of these results will continue following the end of this grant to engage National partners.
 Beginning with a presentation and facilitated discussion at NASPA's October 18-19, 2025 meeting, IPA will review outcomes from the leadership summit, successes and barriers noted from hosted events throughout 2025, and gather feedback on key steps in the roadmap for implementation.
